Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(Fort Sanders) Cumberland Avenue Lane Closure [Overnight, August 13-14] –** KUB crews will close a short section of the westbound lane and turn lane of Cumberland Avenue between S. Twenty-second Street and Volunteer Boulevard to traffic overnight from 9 p.m., Thursday, August 13, through 6 a.m., Friday, August 14, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Westbound traffic will be detoured to S. Twenty-second Street, Lake Avenue, and Volunteer Boulevard. The eastbound lanes will remain open. Access to area businesses will be maintained.

**(S. Knoxville) Lane Closure - Craghead Lane [August 13] –** KUB contract crews will implement lane closures of Craghead Lane between Montlake Drive and Trillium Lane from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., Thursday, August 13, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. The closed lane will vary as work progresses, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
