Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(South Knoxville) Road Closure - Davenport Road [September 2-4]** – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Davenport Road between Sevier Avenue and Boggs Avenue to traffic continuously from 7 a.m., Wednesday, September 2, through 5 p.m., Friday, September 4, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Local access will be maintained, but through traffic should utilize Lippencott Street, Chapman Highway, and Blount Avenue. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
