Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather

permitting]

(Marble City) Division Street Road Closure [Extended Through July 12] – KUB contract crews have extended the continuous closure on a short section of Division Street between Sutherland Avenue and Cary Street through Friday, July 12, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. This work affects the portion of Division Street that is one-way only for westbound traffic. Alternate routes in the area include Sutherland Avenue and Liberty Street. Access to local schools and businesses will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
