Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(Marble City) Division Street Lane Closure [Weekdays, September 18 – November 29] – KUB contract crews will implement daily alternating lane closures of Division Street between Liberty Street and Sutherland Avenue weekdays from 7 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. daily, starting Wednesday, September 18, through Friday, November 29, to allow for safe manhole access in the area. Traffic flow will be maintained at all times. Work will not occur on holidays. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(South Knox) Chapman Highway Intermittent Lane Closure [Daily, September 18-20] – KUB contract crews will implement intermittent lane closures of both the curbside northbound and southbound lanes of Chapman Highway between Quaker Way and Anderson Drive from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. daily, Wednesday, September 18, through Friday, September 20, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Both directions will not be impacted at the same time, and the work zone will shift as work progresses. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
