Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Fourth and Gill) E. Fifth Avenue and Jessamine Street Intersection Closure [Daily, March 19-29] – KUB contract crews will close the E. Fifth Avenue and Jessamine Street intersection daily, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., Monday-Friday, starting Tuesday, March 19, through Friday, March 29, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. The intersection will be re-opened outside of work hours and on weekends. Alternate routes include E. Magnolia Avenue. Access to area businesses and driveways will be maintained. Appropriate signage and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
