Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(North Knoxville) East Inskip Drive Alternating Lane Closures [Extended October 2-4]** – KUB contract crews will implement alternating lane closures on a short section of E. Inskip Drive between Central Avenue Pike and Rowan Road from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. daily, starting Monday, October 2, through Wednesday, October 4, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Crews will be working in both the eastbound and westbound lanes, all will close the necessary lane of traffic as needed. One lane will remain open at all times to alternate traffic flow through the work zone. All lanes will reopen outside of listed work hours. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
