Re: Traffic Advisory - Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are

weather permitting]

(East Knoxville) Lane Closures [October 1-4] – KUB contract crews will implement closures weekdays between 7 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. on the below roadways for ongoing wastewater collection system work in the area:

- Nash Road between Pelham Park Road and Spring Hill Road
- Yankee Street between Nash Road and Asheville Highway

Local traffic access will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Downtown) W. Vine Avenue Intermittent Lane Closure [Overnight, October 1-2] — KUB crews will implement intermittent lane closures of W. Vine Avenue between Locust Street and Walnut Street overnight from 8:30 p.m., Tuesday, October 1, through 5 a.m., Wednesday, October 2, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. One lane of traffic will be maintained through the area. Flaggers and signs will be onsite to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
