Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(Vestal Area) Edington Road Closure [February 18-April 4] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Edington Road between Willoughby Drive and Spruce Drive to through traffic continuously starting Monday, February 18, through Thursday, April 4, as work is performed on the wastewater collection systems in the area. Alternate routes include Cherokee Trail, Candora Road, Willoughby Road, East End Road, and Young Avenue. Access to businesses and driveways will be maintained. Appropriate signage, flaggers, and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(East Knoxville) Boyd's Bridge Pike Road Closure [February 18-22] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Boyd's Bridge Pike between Biddle Street and Fellowship Lane to through traffic from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., from February 18-22, as work is performed on the wastewater collection systems in the area. Alternate routes include Brooks Avenue, Biddle Street, Border Street, and Wimpole Avenue. Access to driveways will be maintained, and the road will reopen to normal traffic flow outside of work hours. Appropriate signage and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills) Arrowhead Trail Road Closure [February 18-22] – KUB contract crews will close Arrowhead Trail between Lyons View Pike and Blows Ferry Road to through traffic from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., from February 18-22, as work is performed on the wastewater collection systems in the area. Access to driveways will be maintained, and the road will reopen to normal traffic flow when construction crews are not present. Appropriate signage and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(North Knoxville) Heiskell Avenue Lane Closure [February 18-22] – KUB contract crews will implement lane closures of a short section of Heiskell Avenue between the northbound I-275 exit ramps and N. Central Street daily, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday February 18, through Friday, February 22, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Access to local businesses will be maintained, as will traffic in both directions. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
