Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane Closures for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Gibbs) Emory Road Lane Closures [July 19-21] – KUB crews will implement the following lane closures to replace two utility poles on sections of Emory Road daily from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.:

- Wednesday, July 19 Eastbound lane of Emory Road at Silveredge Way
- Thursday, July 20, & Friday, July 21 Westbound lane of Emory Road at Stormer Road

One lane of Emory Road will remain open at both locations with flaggers present to alternate traffic flow.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures, including flaggers, channeling devices, and barricades, will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. More information can be found at www.kub.org.

Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
