Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(North Knoxville) Fair Drive Road Closure [August 14-25] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Fair Drive, between Inskip Road and Heins Road, daily, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., beginning on Monday, August 14, lasting through Friday, August 25 (excluding weekends), as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Alternate routes include Inskip Road, Charles Drive, Montrose Road, and Cedar Lane. All lanes will reopen outside of listed work hours and on weekends. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
