Re: Traffic Advisory – Closures for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(Downtown) Fire Street Alley Closure [July 12]** – KUB crews will close a section of Fire Street Alley between Union Avenue and W. Summit Hill Drive from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., Wednesday, July 12, 2023, as work is performed on the water and wastewater systems in the area. Parking access and access to area businesses will be maintained.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures, including flaggers, channeling devices, and barricades, will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
