(Old City) N. Gay Street, W. Depot Avenue Intersection Closure [October 17-26] — KUB contract crews will close the intersection of N. Gay Street and W. Depot Avenue beginning at 7 a.m. on Wednesday, October 17, through 5 p.m. Friday, October 26, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. This closure will remain in effect throughout the weekend. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Alternate routes include N. Broadway and N. Central Street. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
