(South Knoxville) Gov. John Sevier Highway Lane Closure [October 11] – KUB contract crews will close the eastbound, curbside lane of Governor John Sevier Highway between Neubert Springs Road and Marashi Road from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., on Friday, October 11, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Eastbound traffic will be directed into the turn lane, and northbound traffic will be unaffected. Flaggers and signs will be onsite to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
