Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(East Knoxville) S. Harrison Street at Louise Avenue Intersection Closure [Daily, January 6-13. 2022] – KUB contractor crews will close the intersection of S. Harrison Street at Louise Avenue daily between 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., starting Thursday, January 6, and lasting through Thursday, January 13, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Access to driveways will be maintained, and the roadway will reopen to normal traffic flow outside of listed work hours. Alternate routes include Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue, Chestnut Street, and Wilson Avenue. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
