Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(East Knoxville) S. Harrison Street at Louise Avenue Intersection Closure Extended [Daily through January 21, 2022] – KUB contractor crews have extended the intersection closure of S. Harrison Street at Louise Avenue through Friday, January 21. This closure will remain in effect daily between 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Access to driveways will be maintained, and the roadway will reopen to normal traffic flow outside of listed work hours. Alternate routes include Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue, Chestnut Street, and Wilson Avenue. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
