Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather

permitting]

(West Knox) Harvey Road Intermittent Lane Closures [Daily, May 10-31] – KUB contract crews will reduce short sections of Harvey Road to one alternating lane of traffic daily, Monday-Friday, from 7 a.m. – 4 p.m., starting Friday, May 10, through Friday, May 31, as work is performed on the natural gas system in the area. The impacted sections of Harvey Road are:

- Between Choto Road and Mallard Bay Drive
- Between S. Northshore Drive to Hunters Creek Lane

The entire length of the project will not be impacted at one time and will progress as work is completed. Appropriate signage, flaggers, and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
