Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

**(West Haven) Road Closure – Third Creek Road [April 15]** – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Third Creek Road between Western Avenue and Hinton Drive from 8 a.m.- 4 p.m., Monday, April 15, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Alternate routes in the area include Third Creek Road, Hinton Drive, Middlebrook Pike, and Ed Shouse Drive. Appropriate signage and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

**(North Knoxville) Heiskell Avenue and N. Central Street Lane Closures [April 15-16]** – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated lane closures from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. daily, starting Monday, April 15, through Tuesday, April 16, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Heiskell Avenue between the northbound I-275 exit ramps and N. Central Street.
- N. Central Street between Heiskell Avenue and E. Morelia Avenue

The lane closures on N. Central Street will also affect the intersection of N. Central., Bruhin Road, and Heiskell Avenue. Access to local businesses will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

**(North Knoxville) Old Broadway Lane Closure [April 15-18]** – KUB and contract crews will implement lane closure of the northbound, curbside lane of Old Broadway leading to N. Broadway (north to the I-640 overpass), from 9:00 a.m. – 3 p.m., on both Monday, April 15, and Thursday, April 18, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. One northbound lane and both southbound lanes will remain open. Access to businesses will be maintained. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

**(Sequoyah Hills Area) W. Nokomis Circle Road Closure [April 15-19]** – KUB contract crews will close W. Nokomis Circle between Iskagna Drive and E. Nokomis Circle to through traffic, daily from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, April 15, through Friday, April 19, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Alternate routes include E. Nokomis Circle, Southgate Road, Woodside Street, and Kenesaw Avenue. Access to driveways will be maintained. Appropriate signage, barricades, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

**(Sequoyah Hills) Sequoyah Hills Area Road Closures [April 15-19]** – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated road closures daily as needed, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., starting Monday, April 15, through Friday, April 19, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Sequoyah Avenue between Lakeland Drive and Southgate Road – closed intermittently as needed.
- Valenica Road between Alta Vista Way – closed intermittently as needed.
- Taliluna Avenue between Lakeland Drive and Southgate Road – closed intermittently as needed.

Access to area homes will be maintained, and barricades and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
