Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather

permitting]

(Downtown) Henley Street Bridge Lane Closure [Overnight, April 11-12] – KUB crews will close the southbound, curbside lane on the Henley Street Bridge from 9 p.m., Thursday, April 11, through 6 a.m., Friday, April 12, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. The inside southbound lane and both northbound lanes will remain open during this period. The bike lane on the southbound side will also be closed while the work is performed. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
