Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Pond Gap) Hollywood Road [September 28-29] – KUB crews will implement the below traffic control measures as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- **Road Closed** between Papermill Drive and Kelly Place – Saturday, September 28, from 6 a.m. – 6 p.m. Local traffic access maintained. Alternate routes include Sutherland Avenue, Liberty Street, Papermill Drive, and Northshore Drive
- **Lane Closure** – Sunday, September 29, from 6 a.m. – 6 p.m. Northbound lane closed with the southbound lane open to alternate traffic through the work zone.

Flaggers and signs will be onsite to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(South Knoxville) Sevier Avenue Road Closure [September 28] – KUB crews will close a short section of Sevier Avenue between Davenport Road and Claude Street to traffic from 6 a.m. – 6 p.m., on Saturday, September 28, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Alternate routes include Phillips Avenue, Davenport Road, Claude Street, Gertrude Avenue, and Dixie Street. When work progress allows, one alternating lane of traffic will be made available. Flaggers and signs will be onsite to assist with traffic control.

(Halls) E. Emory Road Intermittent Lane Closure [September 30] – KUB contract crews will implement intermittent lane closures of the curbside, eastbound lane of E. Emory Road between Melanie Lane and Shalimar Point Way from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., Monday, September 30, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. One east bound lane, the turn lanes, and both westbound lanes will remain open. The lane will only be closed as necessary to unload equipment. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(North Knoxville) N. Central Street & Heiskell Avenue Lane Closures [Daily, September 30 – October 2] – KUB contract crews will implement lane closures on a short section of the below roadways, Monday-Friday, from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- N. Central Street between Heiskell Avenue and E. Morelia Avenue and
- Heiskell Avenue between the I-275 ramps and N. Central Street

The closed lane will vary depending on worksite conditions, however, traffic flow will be maintained at all times. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Sequoyah Hills Area Traffic Impacts (September 30 – October 4) – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated traffic control measures during work hours, 7 a.m.- 5 p.m., Monday-Friday, September 30 – October 4, as work continues on the wastewater collection system project in the area:

- Intermittent lane closures during work hours:
 - Taliluna Avenue between Agawela Avenue and Southgate Road
 - Agawela Avenue between Cherokee Boulevard and Taliluna Avenue
 - Kenesaw Avenue between Cherokee Boulevard and Taliluna Avenue
- Intermittent road closures as needed during work hours:
 - Bluff View Road between Southgate Road and Holloway Drive

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
