Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(West Knoxville) Homberg Drive Alternating Lane Closures [September 16-17] – KUB crews will implement alternating lane closures on a short section of Homberg Drive between Kingston Pike and S. Mohican Street from 6 a.m. Saturday, September 16, through 4 p.m., Sunday, September 17, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Crews will first close the eastbound lane, then shift to the westbound lane, with one lane remaining open at all times to alternate traffic through the work zone. Access to Ben Atchley Street will be maintained, as will access to all area businesses. Flaggers and appropriate signage will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
