Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(South Knoxville) Island Home Avenue Road Closure [January 26] – KUB crews will close a short section of Island Home Avenue between South Haven Road and Aultman Road to traffic from 7 a.m. – 4 p.m., on Saturday, January 26, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Alternate routes include Maplewood Drive, Fisher Place, South Haven Road, and Island Home Boulevard. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills Area) Arrowhead Trail Road Closure [January 28 – February 1] – KUB contract crews will close Arrowhead Trail between Lyons View Pike and Blows Ferry Road from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. daily, starting Monday, January 28, through Friday, February 1, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. The road will be closed during work hours only for wastewater system work not requiring excavation. Signs will be on site to help with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
