Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Old City) Jackson Avenue Lane Closure [Overnight, September 11-12] – KUB crews will reduce a short section of Jackson Avenue at the Gay Street intersection to one alternating lane of traffic overnight from 9 p.m., Wednesday, September 11, through 5 a.m., Thursday, September 12, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. The adjacent sidewalk and cross walk (The Emporium side of the roadway) will also be closed, and pedestrians should utilize the sidewalk and crosswalk on the west side of the intersection. Traffic flow around the work zone will be maintained via flaggers, and follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
