Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(Downtown Knoxville) James White Parkway & Neyland Drive Road/Ramp Closures & Hall of Fame Drive Rolling Roadblocks [February 19] – KUB crews will implement a series of road/ramp closures and rolling roadblocks at the following locations between 6 – 10 a.m. on Sunday, February 19, as overhead electric lines are installed above roadways just east of Church Street (see attached map):

- CLOSED: I-40 eastbound ramp to southbound James White Parkway
- CLOSED: I-40 westbound ramps to southbound James White Parkway
- CLOSED: Neyland Drive northbound ramp to Hall of Fame Drive
- CLOSED: Neyland Drive northbound ramp to James White Parkway at Main Street
- CLOSED: Anita Drive northbound ramp to James White Parkway
- CLOSED: Northbound lanes on James White Parkway at Riverside Drive off-ramp
- CLOSED: James White Parkway ramp to Riverside Drive
- DETOUR ROUTE with ROLLING ROADBLOCKS: Hall of Fame Drive between Howard Baker Jr. Avenue and Summit Hill Drive

Some closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's *Move Over Law* requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
