Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(West Knoxville) Kingston Pike/Homberg Drive Closures [Overnight, December 16-17] – KUB crews will close the eastbound curbside lane of Kingston Pike between S. Mohican Street and Newcomb Avenue overnight from 9 p.m., Thursday, December 16, through 6 a.m., Friday, December 17, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Homberg Drive also be closed between Kingston Pike and Whittaker Drive in association with this work. One eastbound lane, the center turn lane, and both westbound lanes will remain open on this section of Kingston Pike. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
