Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are

weather permitting]

(Sequoyah Hills) Kingston Pike Lane Closure [Overnight, October 28-29] – KUB crews will close both westbound lanes of Kingston Pike between Scenic Drive and Forest Glen Drive overnight from 10 p.m., Thursday, October 28, through 6 a.m., Friday, October 29, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Westbound traffic will be shifted to one of the eastbound lanes. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
