Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(West Knoxville) Kingston Pike Lane Closure [May 4] – KUB crews will close a short section of the curbside, westbound lane of Kingston Pike between Downtown West Boulevard and S. Gallaher View Road from 9 a.m. – 2 p.m., Tuesday, May 4, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. One westbound lane, the center turn lane, both eastbound lanes, and turn access to area businesses will remain open. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
