Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane Closures for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Sequoyah Hills) Kingston Pike Lane Closure – KUB crews will close a short section of the eastbound right lane on Kingston Pike between Scenic Drive and West Hillvale Turn daily from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m., on Friday, July 14, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. The eastbound left lane and both westbound lanes will remain open on this section of Kingston Pike. Flaggers will be present. Access to driveways will be maintained.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures, including flaggers, channeling devices, and barricades, will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
