(Bearden Area) Kingston Pike Lane Closures [June 18] – KUB crews will implement a lane closure of the eastbound, curbside lane on a short section of Kingston Pike between Westfield Road and Gerald R. Ford Street from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., on Tuesday, June 18, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. One eastbound lane, the center turn lane, and both westbound lanes will remain open. Flaggers and signs will be onsite to assist with traffic control. Wednesday, June 19, will be used as a rain date if necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
