Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Bearden Area) Kingston Pike Lane Closures [Overnight, November 14-15] – KUB crews will implement lane closures of the eastbound, curbside lanes of the below sections of Kingston Pike overnight from 9 p.m., Thursday, November 14, through 6 a.m., Friday, November 15, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area:

- Between Gore Road and Westwood Road
- Between Newcomb Avenue and S. Forest Park Boulevard

Both sections will not be closed at the same time. Crews will first work between Gore Road and Westwood Road before moving to the second location. One eastbound lane, the center turn lane, and both westbound lanes will remain open. Access to area businesses will be maintained.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
