Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(UT Campus Area) Kingston Pike Lane Closures [Overnight, November 18-19] – KUB crews will implement lane closures of both westbound lanes of Kingston Pike between Tyson McGhee Park Street and S. Concord Street from 8 p.m., Thursday, November 18, through 6 a.m., Friday, November 19, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Westbound traffic will be detoured via Volunteer Boulevard, Joe Johnson Drive, and Neyland Drive. All eastbound lanes will remain open. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
