Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(Farragut) Kingston Pike Lane Closures [April 2-5] – KUB crews will implement the below lane closures on Kingston Pike daily from 7:30 a.m. – 4 p.m., Tuesday, April 2, through Friday, April 5, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area:

- The westbound turn lane onto N. Campbell Station Road
- The westbound curbside lane between Jamestowne Boulevard and Glen Abbey Boulevard One westbound lane, the center turn lane, and both eastbound lanes will remain open. Access to businesses will be maintained. Appropriate signage and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Corryton) E. Emory Road Lane Closures [April 2-May 31] – KUB crews will implement intermittent lane closures as needed on a short section of E. Emory Road between Nevada Lane and Openview Lane, daily from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m., starting, Tuesday, April 2, through Friday, May 31, as work is performed on the electric distribution system ahead of a TDOT road-widening project. This work will affect the east-and westbound lanes at different times as overhead lines and poles are located on both sides along this section of E. Emory Road. Crews will limit work to one side of the road a time to avoid a full road closure. At least one lane will be maintained at all times to alternate traffic flow. Access to Fairview Baptist Church will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Marble City Area) Road Closure – Painter Avenue [Extended, April 2-April 26] – KUB contract crews will maintain a closure of Painter Avenue at Concord Street, between Safety City Road and Sullins Street, to through traffic weekdays from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Tuesday, April 2, through Friday, April 12, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Due to extensive excavation, the Painter Avenue intersection at Concord Street will remain closed for the duration of this work. There will be intermittent lane shifts as needed by work crews on Concord Street only during work hours. Saturday, April 13, through Friday, April 26, this section of Painter Avenue will be closed continuously. Alternate routes include Jersey Avenue, Sullins Street, and Safety City Road. Local traffic access will be maintained. Appropriate signage, flaggers, and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
