Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(West Knoxville) Kingston Pike Lane Closures [January 5 & 6]** – KUB crews will close both the westbound lanes of Kingston Pike between Lindsey Place and Thimbleberry Way from 7 a.m. – 4 p.m., on Saturday, January 5, and Sunday, January 6, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. The eastbound lanes will be used for both eastbound and westbound traffic. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control.

**(East Knoxville) Loves Creek Road Closure [Rescheduled, January 7]** – KUB crews will close a short section of Loves Creek Road between Rutledge Pike and Parker Drive to traffic from 7 a.m. – 3 p.m., on Monday, January 7, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Parker Drive will be the alternate route. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

**(Downtown) E. Summit Hill Drive Lane, Patton Street Road Closure [January 7-9]** – KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures from 7 a.m., Monday, January 7, through 5 p.m., Wednesday, January 9, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area:

- Westbound, curbside lane of E. Summit Hill Drive at the Patton Street intersection closed. One westbound lane and both eastbound lanes will remain open, as will turn access to area businesses.
- Patton Street between Willow Avenue and Campbell Avenue closed. N. Central Street is the alternate route.

Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control, and follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

**(Farragut) Kingston Pike Lane Closure [January 7-18]** – KUB crews will close the westbound, curbside lane of Kingston Pike between Jamestowne Boulevard and Glen Abbey Boulevard from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. daily, Monday-Friday, starting Monday, January 7, through Friday, January 18, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. One westbound lane, the center turn lane, and both eastbound lanes will remain open. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control.

**(South Knoxville) Candora Road Lane Closure [Extended, January 7-31]** – KUB contract crews will close a short section of the southbound, lane of Candora Road between Log Haven Drive and Army Street daily, from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., beginning Monday, January 7, through Thursday, January 31, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. The northbound lane will remain open at this time to allow traffic through the area. Access to area homes will be maintained. Work will not occur on weekends or during the holidays. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place

at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
