Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(West Knoxville) Kingston Pike and Noelton Drive Lane, Road Closure [October 18] –**

KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. on Thursday, October 18, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Both the westbound and eastbound turn lanes of Kingston Pike at Noelton Drive CLOSED (eastbound and westbound traffic will be maintained)
- Noelton Drive between Kingston Pike and Shawnee Lane CLOSED

Eastbound and westbound Kingston Pike traffic will be maintained while through traffic will not be maintained through the intersection. Noelton Drive should be accessed via Mellen Avenue, Towanda Trail, Hiwatha Drive, or Scenic Drive. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
