Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(West Knox) Kingston Pike Lane Closure [Overnight, June 25-26] – KUB crews will implement a closure of the curbside, eastbound lane of Kingston Pike between Walker Springs Road and Gallaher View Road overnight from 10 p.m., Thursday, June 25, through 6 a.m., Friday, June 26, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. One eastbound lane, the center turn lane, and both westbound lanes will remain open as will access to area businesses.

(Marble City) Sutherland Avenue Lane Closure [Overnight, June 25-26] – KUB crews will reduce a short section of Sutherland Avenue to one alternating lane of traffic between Donald Lee Derrickson Avenue and N. Concord Street overnight from 10 p.m., Thursday, June 25, through 6 a.m., Friday, June 26, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. The westbound lane will be closed while the eastbound lane remains open to alternate traffic through the work zone. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
