Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown Road Closure) Locust Street [Tuesday, November 16] – KUB contractor crews will close the section of Locust Street between Cumberland Avenue and W. Church Avenue to traffic from 8:30 a.m.-1 p.m., Tuesday, November 16, for paving and roadway restoration following recent water system work in the area. On street parking will be closed during this time, as will the sidewalk on the west side of the roadway. The impacted section will reopen after work hours. Alternate routes include W. Church Avenue and S. Gay Street. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
