Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(Halls Crossroads) Maynardville Pike Lane Closures [Daily, September 12-20] – KUB contractor crews will intermittently close the outside north- and southbound lanes and adjacent roadway shoulders on the section of Maynardville Pike between Rifle Range Road and Andersonville Pike daily 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., September 12-20 (no weekend closures) as work is performed on the overhead electric system in the area. At least one lane will remain open in both directions while this work is performed. Lane/shoulder closures will be limited to the immediate area where crews are working. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with maintaining traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
