Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Halls Crossroad) Maynardville Pike Road Closure [March 4] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of the southbound, curbside lane of Maynardville Pike from Neal Drive to Fountain Valley Drive to through traffic from 9:30 a.m. – 3 p.m., on Monday, March 4, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. One southbound lane, the center turn lane and both northbound lanes with remain open. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(East Knoxville Area) Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue Road Closure [Overnight, March 4-5] – KUB crews will close a short section of Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue between Fern Street and Prosser Road to traffic overnight from 9 p.m., Monday, March 4, through 6 a.m., Tuesday, March 5, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Alternate routes include Kirkland Street, Holston Drive, and Prosser Road. Access to businesses will be maintained. Appropriate signage and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(North Knoxville) N. Central Street Lane Closures [March 4-8] – KUB contract crews will implement lane closures of a short section of N. Central Street between E. Morelia Avenue and Heiskell Avenue daily, from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., starting Monday, March 4, through Friday, March 8, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Due to the method of sewer replacement being used, the work may run beyond the window in the late afternoon. The closed lane will vary based on the work being completed; however, traffic flow in both directions will be maintained, as will access to local businesses. Follow-up advisories will be issues as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills) Kenesaw Avenue Road Closure [March 4-8] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Kenesaw Avenue between Woodland Drive and Iskagna Drive to through traffic from 7 a.m.- 5 p.m. daily, starting Monday, March 4, through Friday, March 8, as work is performed on the wastewater collection systems in the area. Alternate routes include Keowee Avenue, Woodside Street, Windgate Street, and Oakhurst Drive. Access to businesses and driveways will be maintained. Appropriate signage and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills) Keowee Avenue Road Closure [March 4-8] – KUB contract crews will close Keowee Avenue between Southgate Road and West Nokomis Circle to through traffic from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. daily, starting Monday, March 4, through Friday, March 8, as work is performed on the wastewater collection systems in the area. Alternate routes include Sequoyah Avenue, Taliluna Avenue, Wilani Road, and Agawela Avenue. Access to driveways and local businesses will be maintained. Appropriate signage and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas.
