Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are

weather permitting]

(West Knoxville) Morrell Drive Lane

KUB crews will implement lane closures on Morrell Road between Gleason Drive and Deane Hill on Sunday, November 6, 2022, starting at 7 a.m. and ending at 3 p.m. Lane closures will be limited to the immediate area where crews are working. Crews will maintain one open lane to alternate traffic flow. Access to connecting side streets will also be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
