Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are

weather permitting]

(Sequoyah Hills) Southgate Road Lane Closure [Extended December 20 & 21] – KUB crews will reduce a section of Southgate Road to one alternating lane of traffic between Scenic Drive and Bluff View Road, from 9 a.m. – 1:30 p.m., Tuesday, December 20, and Wednesday, December 21, as construction prep work, including saw cutting of asphalt, is performed in this area. The northbound lane will be closed while the southbound lane remains open and is used to alternate traffic. All lanes will reopen outside of listed work hours. Electronic message boards, flaggers, and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control, and local traffic access to driveways will be maintained.

(Fort Sanders Area) Highland Avenue Road Closure [December 21 & December 22] – KUB contract crews will close a section of Highland Avenue between Eighteenth Street and Seventeenth Street 8 a.m. - 5 p.m., on Wednesday, December 21, and Thursday, December 22, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Alternate routes include Laurel Avenue, Clinch Avenue, Seventeenth Street and Eighteenth Street. During work hours, on-street parking on the north side of Highland Avenue will NOT be available. Vehicles must be moved before 7 a.m. or they will be towed. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(North Knoxville) Road Closure- East Inskip Road [December 21] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of East Inskip Road, between Cedar Lane and Henrietta Drive, from 9 a.m. – 5 p.m., on Wednesday, December 21, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Alternate routes include Cedar Lane, Henrietta Drive, Charles Drive, and Montrose Road. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control.

(North Knoxville) Road Closure- East Inskip Road [December 22 & 23] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of East Inskip Road, between Cedar Lane and Henrietta Drive, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., on Thursday, December 22, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Roadway repair work will occur during the same hours on Friday, December 23, only in the event that work is not completed on December 22. Alternate routes include Cedar Lane, Henrietta Drive, Charles Drive, and Montrose Road. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control.





Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
