- Re: Traffic Advisory Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown) Henley Street and N. Broadway Lane Closure [Overnight, October 22-23] – KUB crews will implement lane closures in the below intersections as needed for safe manhole access overnight, from 9 p.m., Tuesday, October 22, through 5 a.m., Wednesday, October 23:

- Henley Street and N. Broadway Intersection
- N. Broadway and W. Jackson Avenue intersection (including the sidewalk in this location)

Traffic flow will be maintained in all directions through the intersection. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Old City) E. Jackson Avenue Lane Closure [Overnight, October 23-24] – KUB crews will reduce a short section of E. Jackson Avenue between S. Central Street and Morgan Street to one alternating lane of traffic overnight from 10 p.m., Wednesday, October 23, through 7 a.m., Thursday, October 24, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. The eastbound lane will be closed while the westbound lane remains open to alternate traffic through the work zone. Access to local businesses will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Old City) S. Gay Street Lane Closure [Overnight, October 23-24] – KUB crews will reduce a short section of S. Gay Street between Summit Hill Drive and W. Vine Avenue to one alternating lane of traffic overnight from 9 p.m., Wednesday, October 23, through 5 a.m., Thursday, October 24, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. The northbound lane will be closed while the southbound lane remains open to alternate traffic through the work zone. Access to local businesses will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
