Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(Downtown) Multiple Traffic Impacts [July 10-13]** – KUB crews will implement the below traffic control measures as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area:

- Daily intermittent lane closure - Inside, eastbound lane of W. Summit Hill Drive between Henley Street and Locust Street
- Daily intermittent road closure - Union Avenue between Locust Street and Walnut Street
- Nightly from 11 p.m. – 6 a.m. - Road closure of Union Avenue between Walnut Street and S. Gay Street.

On-street parking will be closed in the work zone during work hours, including on-street parking on S. Gay Street between Union Avenue and Clinch Avenue. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
