Re: Traffic Advisory - Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather

permitting]

(North Knoxville) Dutch Valley Drive Road Closure [January 19] – KUB crews will close a short section of Dutch Valley Drive between Appalachian Way and The Hague to traffic from 6 a.m. – 4 p.m., on Saturday, January 19, as work is performed on the water distribution and wastewater collection systems in the area. Alternate routes include Plummer Road, Adair Drive, Broadway, Old Broadway, and Bruhin Road. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills Area) Arrowhead Trail Road Closure [January 22-25] – KUB contract crews will close Arrowhead Trail between Lyons View Pike and Blows Ferry Road from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. daily, starting Tuesday, January 22, through Friday, January 25, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. The road will be closed during work hours only for wastewater system work not requiring excavation. Signs will be on site to help with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills Area) Noelton Drive Road Closure [January 22- February 21] — KUB crews will close a short section of Noelton Drive between Kingston Pike and Alta Vista Drive to traffic from 7:30 a.m. Monday through 5 p.m. Friday, beginning Tuesday, January 22, through Thursday, February 21, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Shawnee Drive will be an alternate route. Local traffic access will be maintained, and the roadway will reopen on weekends. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(South Knox) Sevierville Pike Road Closure [January 22] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Sevierville Pike between Evans Road and Trotter Road to traffic from 9 a.m. - 1 p.m., on Tuesday, January 22, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Evans Road, Chapman Highway, E. Hendron Chapel Road, White School Road, Bays Mountain Road, Widener Road, and Trotter Road are all alternate routes. Local traffic access will be maintained, and appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.





(Old City) State Street Road and W. Jackson Avenue Lane Closures [Overnight, January 22-23] – KUB crews will implement the below traffic control measures overnight from 9 p.m., Tuesday, January 22, through 6 a.m., Wednesday, January 23, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area:

- State Street between W. Jackson Avenue and W. Summit Hill Drive closed
- W. Jackson Avenue at State Street reduced to one alternating lane of traffic Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control, and access to local parking will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
