- Re: Traffic Advisories Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(West Knoxville) Ball Camp Pike Road Closure [October 27 & 28] – KUB crews will close a short section of Ball Camp Pike between Hazelwood Road and Kingsmore Drive from 6 a.m. – 6 p.m., on Saturday, October 27 and Sunday, October 28, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Alternate routes include Western Avenue, Pleasant Ridge Road, and Hazelwood Road. Access to Kingsmore Drive will be maintained. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(North Knoxville) N. Central Street Lane Closure [October 29] – KUB crews will close a short section of northbound N. Central Street between E. Springdale Avenue and E. Burwell Avenue from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., on Monday, October 29, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. The southbound lane will remain open, and the center turn lane will be used for northbound traffic. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary, and Tuesday, October 30, will be used as a rain date if necessary.

(South Knoxville) Maryville Pike Lane Closure [October 29 & 30] – KUB crews will reduce a short section of Maryville Pike near Candora Avenue to one alternating lane of traffic from 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. daily, on Monday, October 29, and Tuesday, October 30, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. One alternating lane of traffic will be maintained through the work zone at all times. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary

(Old City) W. Jackson Avenue Lane Closure [October 29-31] – KUB contract crews will reduce a short section of W. Jackson Avenue between N. Central Street and State Street to one alternating lane of traffic from 7 a.m. – 4 p.m. daily, starting Monday, October 29, through Wednesday, October 31, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. The closed lane will alternate as work progresses, and one alternating lane of traffic will be maintained through the work zone at all times. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills) Sequoyah Hills Area Road Closures [October 29-November 2] – KUB contract crews will implement the below road closures as needed daily, Monday-Friday, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., October 29-November 2, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Hiawatha Drive between Noelton Drive and Towanda Trail
- Chippewa Circle between Noelton Drive
- Noelton Drive between Kingston Pike and Alta Vista Way
- Chickasaw Road between Cherokee Boulevard and Navaho Road

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
