Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(North Knox) N. Broadway Lane Closure [November 30 & December 1]** – KUB crews will close a short section of the curbside, northbound lane of N. Broadway between Rennoc Road and Highland Drive daily between 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., Tuesday, November 30, and Wednesday, December 1, as work is performed on the overhead electric system in the area. One northbound lane, the center turn lane, and both southbound lanes will remain open. Business access will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

**(Downtown) Henley Street & Locust Street Lane Closures [Overnight, November 30-December 1]** – KUB crews will intermittently close the inside northbound and southbound lanes on Henley Street between Clinch Avenue and Cumberland Avenue overnight from 8 p.m., Tuesday, November 30, through 5 a.m., Wednesday, December 1, as work is performed on the electric system in the area. One northbound lane and all remaining southbound lanes on this section of Henley Street will remain open. Additionally, crews will intermittently close the right turn lane on eastbound W. Church Avenue and one southbound lane on Locust Street at the intersection of both streets during the same time frame. The sidewalk will also be closed in this area. One eastbound lane of W. Church Avenue and one southbound lane of Locust Street will remain open.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
