Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(North Knoxville) N. Broadway Lane Closure [February 21] – KUB crews will close the southbound curbside lane of traffic on a short section of N. Broadway at the Karnes Avenue intersection from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m., Tuesday, February 21, as work is performed on the water distribution system. The inside southbound lane and both northbound lanes will remain open on this section of N. Broadway.

Some closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's *Move Over Law* requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
