(Fort Sanders) N. Seventeenth Street & Dale Avenue Lane Closures [Overnight, October 29-30] – KUB crews will implement a lane closures on the below roadways overnight from 11 p.m., Tuesday, October 29, through 4 a.m., Wednesday, October 30, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area:

- Northbound, curbside lane of N. Seventeenth Street between Dale Avenue and Grand Avenue. One northbound lane and both southbound lanes will remain open.
- Center turn lane of Dale Avenue at N. Seventeenth Street. The right turn lane will remain open, and eastbound traffic will be directed through the left-hand turn lane.

Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
