Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(Edgewood) N. Sixth Avenue Road Closure [September 20]** – KUB crews will close a short section of N. Sixth Avenue between Cecil Avenue and Hoitt Avenue to through traffic from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. on Friday, September 20, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Access to the Brown Avenue intersection will be maintained. Alternate routes include Cecil avenue, Seventh Avenue, Brown Avenue, And Luttrell Street. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
