Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(North Knoxville) N. Broadway Lane Closure [Overnight, February 3-4] – KUB crews will implement a closure of the curbside, northbound lane at 4800 N. Broadway, between Adair Drive and Sanders Drive, starting at 10 p.m., Wednesday, February 3, through 6 a.m., Thursday, February 4, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. One northbound lane, the center turn lane, and both southbound lanes will remain open. Turn access to area businesses will also be maintained.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
