Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(North Knoxville) N. Broadway Lane Closures [October 12 & 13] – KUB crews will close a short section of the southbound, curbside lane of N. Broadway between Sanders Drive and Woodrow Drive from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. on Thursday, October 12, and Friday, October 13, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. The sidewalk in this area will also be closed during this time. One southbound lane, the center turn lane, and both northbound lanes will remain open during this time. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control, and access to area businesses will be maintained.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
