Re: Traffic Advisory - Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are

weather permitting]

(East Knoxville) Road Closure – Nash Road [Weekdays, September 9-27] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Nash Road to traffic between Pelham Park Road and Spring Hill Road from 7 a.m. – 6:30 p.m., weekdays starting Monday, September 9, through Friday, September 27, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Alternate routes include Old State Road, Pelham Park Road, Nash Road, and Jonteel Drive. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Sequoyah Hills Area Traffic Impacts (September 9-13) – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated traffic control measures during work hours, 7 a.m.- 5 p.m., Monday-Friday, September 9-13, as work continues on the wastewater collection system project in the area:

- Intermittent lane closures during work hours:
 - Kenesaw Avenue between Cherokee Boulevard and Taliluna Avenue
 - Taliluna Avenue between Agawela Avenue and Southgate Road
- Intermittent road closures as needed during work hours:
 - o Agawela Avenue between Cherokee Boulevard and Taliluna Avenue

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
